


At the centre of the home, the renovated kitchen blends style and practicality. Caesarstone benchtops, a striking pressed tin splashback, generous storage and a Bosch oven with gas cooktop are complemented by a large island bench - the natural gathering place for cooking, conversation and casual meals.

The adjoining living area is warmed by a slow combustion fireplace,

Accommodation includes four generous bedrooms and three bathrooms, offering excellent flexibility for families. The main bedroom includes a spacious walk in robe and ensuite, while two additional bedrooms include built in wardrobes.
