Step into a piece of history with this exceptional estate in the Bega Valley, an exquisite property built around 1847 that embodies timeless beauty and historic charm. Nestled on approximately six acres along the Bega River, with 2 separate titles and just a few kilometres from town, this estate includes three unique dwellings, each meticulously preserved and thoughtfully updated to harmonize with the estate's heritage.

The main residence, Tarraganda House, is a stately Colonial Georgian home crafted from locally handmade bricks, boasting 18-inch thick walls, 14-foot-high ceilings, and a high-pitched roof with tall chimneys. Its symmetrical design, deep wrap around verandas, and tall chimneys showcase a grand aesthetic. Originally constructed with King George's era architecture in mind, the main homestead now has three bedrooms, two bathrooms, a dining room, a lounge, and a large, eat-in kitchen, all with sweeping views of the valley, river, and gardens. Over the years, subtle additions, including recent upgrades

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to the heating, have been made to enhance modern living while preserving its Colonial roots.

The second dwelling, Tarraganda Cottage, built in the 1860s, was initially designed as a detached kitchen for the main house. With its original baker's oven, a new woodfire heater, and high ceilings adorned with original boards, the cottage exudes authenticity. It features two bedrooms, a kitchen, and a bathroom, all recently renovated with the same reverence for history seen in Tarraganda House. The wrap-around verandas offer a perfect balance of sun and shade, creating an inviting retreat all year round.

The Gardener's Cottage, on its own separate title, is yet another enchanting feature, originally built to house the estate's Chinese gardener. With one bedroom, a bathroom, kitchen, and living area, this cozy abode has its own separate entrance and title, offering a private sanctuary filled with charm and character.

Beyond the homes, the gardens and manicured lawns are breathtaking, with a sense of beauty that cannot be fully captured in photos. To complete this remarkable property, rustic stables stand as a tribute to the estate's history, while a five-bay machinery shed offers convenient storage for equipment, trailers, and more. A chook yard, veggie garden and open paddocks down to the stunning Bega River, this property has it all!

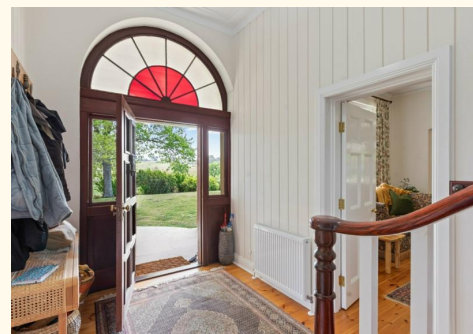

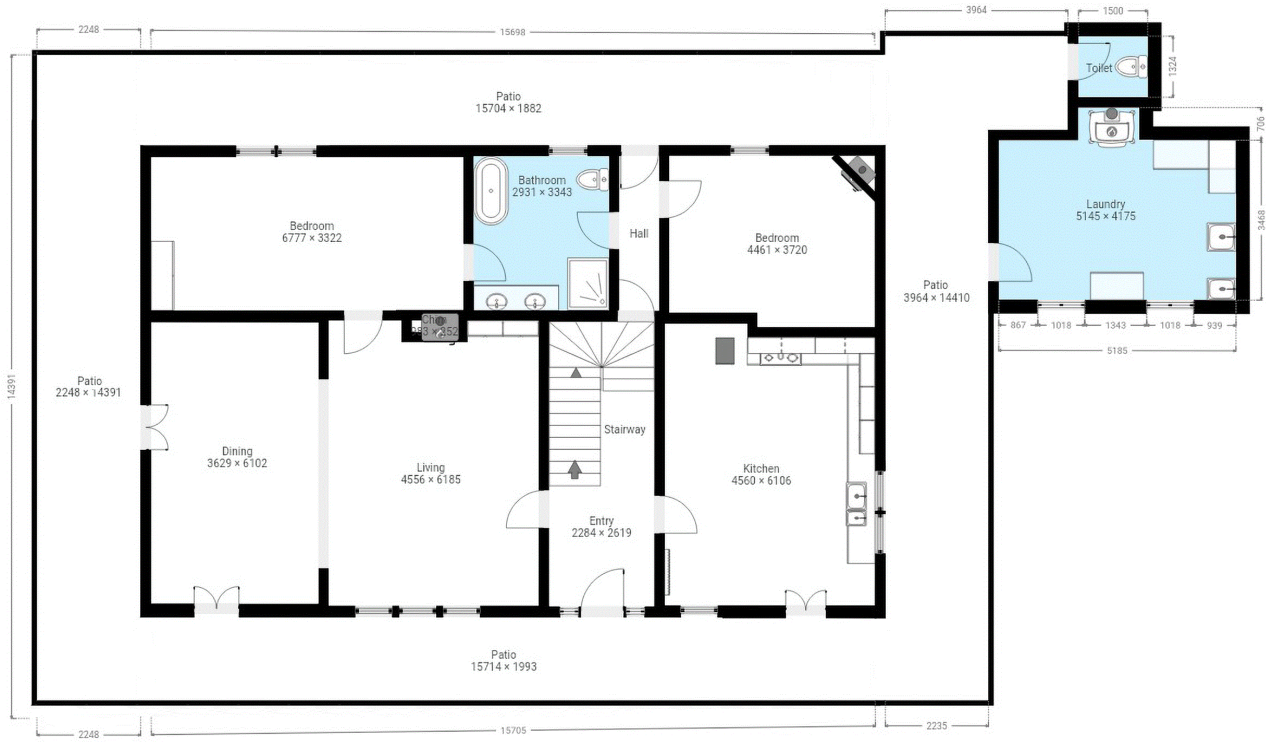
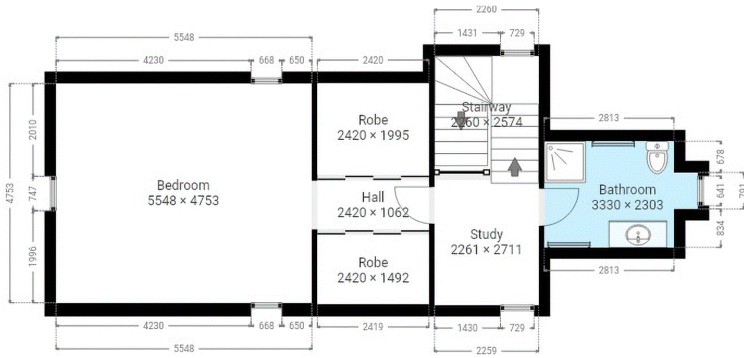
